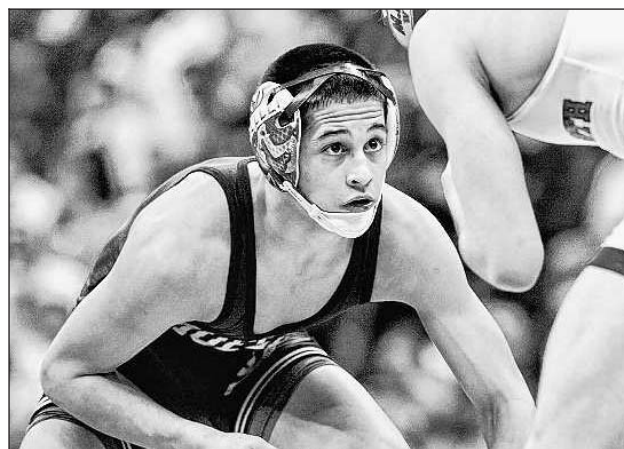

Dick McCoy, Elder: He led the Panthers to a fourth-place finish at the state tournament. Elder was district runner-up.

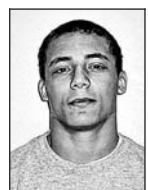

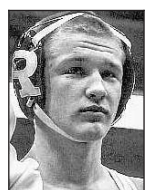
